



California Academy of Sciences Pre-Visit Health Self-Screening

Your safety is our priority. In order to enter the Academy, all guests must complete this health self-screening. If anyone in your party can answer “yes” to any of the questions below, you will not be permitted to enter the Academy and will be invited to reschedule your visit for another day.

1. In the last 24 hours, including today, have you had ANY of the symptoms below, that is new or not explained by another condition?

- » fever (100.4°F/38°C or greater)
- » chills or shivering
- » cough, sore throat
- » shortness of breath, difficulty breathing
- » feeling unusually weak or fatigued
- » loss of taste or smell
- » muscle or body aches
- » headache
- » vomiting or diarrhea, nausea
- » runny or congested nose

2. In the past 10 days, have you been diagnosed with COVID-19 or had a test confirming you have the virus?

3. In the past 10-14 days, have you had “close contact” with anyone who has COVID-19, during their contagious period? “Close contact” includes:

- » being within 6 feet of them for a total of 15 minutes or more in a 24-hour period
- » having direct contact with their bodily fluids (coughed or sneezed on you or shared food utensils)
- » living or staying overnight with them
- » having physical or intimate contact, including hugging and kissing
- » taking care of them, or having them take care of you
